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MWVSRC has once again opened their doors to the community.

We are still providing services to our community by phone for those who wish to continue to socially distance.

Outreach will be available on a case by case basis.

Both of our recovery support meetings that meet on Thursday nights have resumed. SMART Recovery starts at 6 pm and F.A.S.T.E.R. at 6:30 pm. These meetings are currently being held online. Refer to the Schedule of Programs page on our website for how to attend.

If you call the center, a MWVSRC staff member will get back to you to address your needs. We ask that if you have a scheduled meeting that you do so over the phone at this time.

When we do allow clients to begin meeting us at the center, the following protocol will take place to protect us all:

- 1. WHEN YOU ARRIVE PLEASE KNOCK OR CALL 603-662-0668 - A STAFF MEMBER WILL ADDRESS YOU AT THE DOOR.**
- 2. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO ANSWER A BRIEF CONFIDENTIAL QUESTIONNAIRE / SCREENING BEFORE ENTERING THE FACILITY**
- 3. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO SUBMIT TO A TEMPERATURE READING -HANDS OFF SCAN**
- 4. IF YOUR TEMPERATURE IS GREATER THAN 98.6 OR YOU ANSWERED YES TO ANY OF THE QUESTIONS ON THE SCREEN WE MUST ASK YOU TO RETURN HOME AND INTERACT WITH US BY TELEPHONE.**
- 5. IF YOU PASS THE SCREENING YOU WILL BE ASKED TO WEAR A MASK DURING YOUR APPOINTMENT / MEETING (IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A MASK WE WILL PROVIDE ONE) HAND WASHING, SANITATION WIPES AND SOLUTIONS ARE ALSO AVAILABLE.**
